The IMHSeC group (a partnership between The Pharmaceutical Serious Mental Health Initiative (PSMI), the Department of Health Mental Health Directorate and the former National Mental Health Development Unit) is working with the PbR Quality & Outcomes sub group. The IMHSeC project has made an approach to the National Collaborating Centre as a potential host for the web site and discussions are ongoing to progress this development. To date the content of care packages for all clusters is nearing completion and an initial prototype of the web based tool for their demonstration will be available by autumn 2011.

This Group is to produce guidance on which interventions should be delivered/commissioned in each of the clusters.
